Frequently Asked Questions for FedX, UPS, USPS or walk-in **State Run** civil process filings:

- ➤ How much is the service fee for Secretary of State and how many document copies are required?
 - 1) The Secretary of State has an additional \$55.00 fee due upon receipt of filing. Please make checks payable to "Secretary of State."
 - 2) Include one (1) original of the citation/petition for processing and two (2) additional copies to forward to the Secretary of State.
- How much is a Writ of Garnishment?
 - 1) The process service fee is \$115.00. Please make checks payable to "Travis County Constable Precinct Five."
 - 2) Include one (1) original of the writ for processing and one (1) copy to serve the agency.
- Are there additional fees when serving the Texas Department of Transportation at 125 E. 11th Street?
 - 1) There is an additional \$25.00 fee. Please make checks payable to "TX DOT."
 - 2) Include one (1) original of the citation/petition for processing and two (2) additional copies to forward to the Texas Department of Transportation.
- > \$80.00 Service Fee Checks made payable to "Travis County Constable Precinct Five"
 - Citations (County/District Court, Small Claims and Justice Court)
 - Subpoena (Civil)
 - Summons (Civil)
